CALGARY, AB - FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE The Zenith Canada Pathways Foundation (ZCPF) opened its Call for Applications to Canada's First Space Fellowship, the Zenith Fellowship, on September 9th 2021. The ZCPF facilitates Work-Integrated-Learning (WIL) opportunities Canada-wide, complemented by senior-level mentorship and professional development training, with the first class of Fellows to be announced in early 2022.

Selection criteria will evaluate submitted content and creative pieces, external references, community involvement and academic proficiency with a focus on equity, diversity, and inclusion to select Zenith Fellows for matched placements with Host Organizations and External Mentors within the Canadian aerospace industry. The ZCPF strongly encourages all gender identities, Indigenous and visible minority students and recent graduates to apply. Applicants can apply at www.zenithpathways.ca/apply.

- Currently enrolled in an undergraduate program OR have recently completed an undergraduate degree (or equivalent) within the last 3 years
- Are a Canadian citizen, permanent resident of Canada, or a person granted refugee status in Canada who is legally entitled to work according to your provincial legislation regulations
- Available to work starting Summer 2022 (remote work available should COVID-19 restrictions be in place during time of internship)

With Canada's space and aerospace sectors at a crossroad, the Zenith Fellowship intends to build a foundational cohort of Canadian talent by facilitating opportunities for early career professionals and students to up-skill, acquire senior-level guidance and kickstart their Canadian careers right here at home.
